Since 2022, the ACURE4Moms study has made great strides towards increasing awareness of maternal health inequities across North Carolina. We are so proud of the dedicated team members who are making this important research study possible.

Updates



Recruitment & Enrollment:

- 49 sites randomized
- 38 sites started Intervention with 16,118 patients enrolled
- 2 sites pending intervention start

Longitudinal Patient Survey (LPS)

- 4,000 potentially eligible participants1,331 assessed for eligibility as of
- 08/07/24
- 619 enrolled
- 830 completed surveys •

24 CBRCs (Community-Based Research Consultants) have been successfully trained to undertake the critical task of recruiting patients for the LPS. 3 additional CBRC's are being oriented and onboarded

Maternal Health Equity Education & Training (MHEET) sessions with clinic providers and staff have also played a vital role in ACURE4Moms, with 88 sessions completed so far.
